



“School Mo Panalo” is the Smart Schools Program Website’s Points and Reward System for its active contributors and contest participants

### Objectives

- to encourage teachers and students to contribute content and participate in SSP website activities
- to acknowledge active partner schools through a rewards system where they can earn points and exchange these for school supplies or multimedia equipment as rewards.

### Mechanics

1. All SSP partner schools are invited to contribute articles for the SSP website and to join the Point System.
2. Article contributions fall under the following categories:
  - 2.1 NEWS
  - 2.2 FEATURES
  - 2.3 SMART TOOLS
3. Article contributions must include the name of the author, school, designation, and contact number. Articles and/or supporting photos can be submitted via email to [smartschools@smart.com.ph](mailto:smartschools@smart.com.ph).
4. SMART reserves the right to choose which articles or entries will be published online.
5. The following is the criteria for the publishing of articles or entries:
  - 5.1 **CONTENT – 60%**
    - Information (verity, originality, and relevance/significance to the website)
    - Supporting information (photos, links, etc.)
  - 5.2 **COMPOSITION – 40%**
    - Structure and Grammar
    - Appeal and value
6. Every published article and entries under the Gimmicks section will have an equivalent point which will be credited to the participating school’s total points.
7. Contributors will receive individual tokens from Smart.
8. Contributors whose articles are published can also be given a certificate of contribution upon request.
9. The number of Gimmick entries per school will be subject to the limitations of the Gimmick’s mechanics.
10. Accumulated points of every participating school will be tallied every quarter, and at the end of the school year. School points will be announced and posted in the SSP website every quarter.
11. Tallied points will have a corresponding reward. Participants have the option to claim their reward every quarter, upon which the school’s accumulated points will be reverted to zero. The school can also let their points accumulate at the end of the school year in exchange for a bigger reward.
12. The school(s) with the highest total points at the end of the school year will also get the grand prize aside from the reward that it will earn based on the rewards schedule. In case of a tie between two schools, both schools will get the grand prize.
